

## ***Women's Studies Group Bursary Application Form 2023***

The Women's Studies Group 1558-1837 is offering a £750 bursary to an early career researcher or independent scholar to support research in any aspect of women's studies in the period 1558-1837. The grant may be awarded for a new or continuing interdisciplinary or single-discipline project or for a project that has part-funding from another source.

Applicants must

- Be members of the Women's Studies Group at the time of the application, regardless of where they are based (including overseas membership)
- Be an early career researcher\*, independent scholar or PhD student
- Give a clear breakdown of their costings (e.g., fares and accommodation/subsistence for archive or library visits, photocopying fees, image reproduction costs and/or image license fees for publication, conference attendance costs, the cost of childcare or other caring responsibilities)
- Indicate, if the application is for part funding, where the rest of the money will come from
- Be realistic about how much fares and accommodation cost (we all know that it is difficult to find a night's stay in London for less than £100).

The bursary holder will normally be refunded on presentation of receipts up to £750 and will be responsible for costs arising from foreign currency transactions (exchange fees, changes in the exchange rate). They will be expected to provide the committee with a report (c. 500 words) at the time that they claim reimbursement and to give a seminar at one of the Women's Studies Group meetings, no later than March 2025, in person or by Zoom.

Applications should be made using this form (boxes will expand) and should be accompanied by CV **of no more than 2 pages standard font**. All applicants should select read and/or delivery receipts for their submission.
